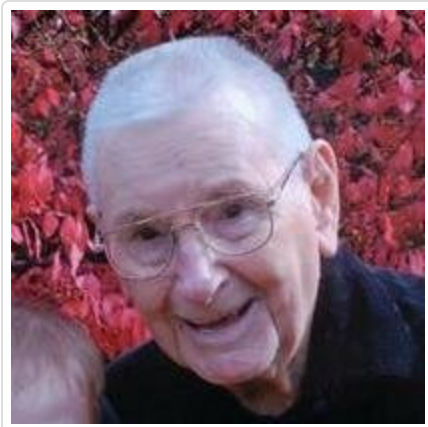




Mr. Vincent E. Robinson

Vincent served his country with the U.S. Army during WWII in England, France, and Germany from 1943-1946.
