She was a graduate of Lowell High School, and then worked at the State House in Boston. She met her future husband Bob when she worked at Fort Devens. They married in 1954 and were happily married for 34 years until Bob died in 1988. Their passion was their summer business at York Beach, Maine where they owned rental property,

Her hobbies included cooking, knitting, reading and traveling. When Bob was alive they took cruises in the Caribbean, and then after he died she traveled with a Congregational Church group from Dracut. She traveled to Germany, England, Ireland, Scotland, Israel, Morroco, the Rock of Gibralter, France, Russia, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Estonia, Finland, and the Netherlands.

Another important hobby was genealogy. The English side of her family came to Massachusetts in the 1620's, and Barbara enjoyed researching her early New England ancestors.

Life presented her with challenges which she was able to take in stride. Her first child was stillborn, her husband died far too young, and she lost her vision in early 2015.

All in all, she lived a full 86 years.
