LOWELL—Leah Ethel (Flanagan) Platt, 70, passed away from a short, difficult battle with Leukemia on January 1, 2017 at Town and Country Health Care Center, surrounded by her loving family. She was the devoted wife of Paul S. Platt, Sr. who died on April 28, 2000.

Leah was born in Boston on September 2, 1946, a daughter of the late Leo Patrick Flanagan and Ethel (Clifford) Flanagan of Cambridge, MA.
