Taimn was born in Battambang, Cambodia in 1930. He served as a soldier in the Cambodian Army before coming to the United States in 1984. His last visit to his village was in 2017.

Mr. Tounn's long life was a mix of bitter and sweet memories. Escaping the Cambodian Holocaust in the late 1970s he lead his family to America where they prospered and built a life of peace. He has left a legacy of strong and caring individuals that were inspired by his tough demeanor and kind heart. A selfless and generous man, he always put the needs of his family and friends before his own. He devoted his life to his wife's happiness, welfare and well-being.

Mr. Tounn enjoyed gardening, playing cards, quiet time with his wife and large family gatherings at his home. A twinkle would always come to his eyes when talking to his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

He is survived by his loving wife, Sophy Vann; his seven children, Chanthou Seang, Kunthea Tounn, Vissna Tounn, Sophat Mar, Sophek Tounn, Channa Martin, and Channy Chorn; 23 grandchildren; 3 great grandchildren. Mr. Tounn was the father of the late Tun Tounn who passed away in 1994.
