LOWELL—Alfred Lucien Lapointe, the beloved husband of Judith (Arches) Lapointe, passed away peacefully on Saturday afternoon, August 17, 2013 at his home, just one day before his 77th birthday. He was surrounded by his loving family.

Alfred was born in Lowell on August 18, 1936, one of eleven children of the late Alexander and Blanche (Boisvert) Lapointe. He attended the Lowell Schools. At the age of 17, Alfred enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. He served honorably for three years, from 1953 until 1956 attaining the rank of Sergeant. Mr. Lapointe served for over a year and a half in the Philippines, where he met and married his wife Judith.

They returned to the United States from his military service and made their home in Lowell, raising three children, Alfred, Marc, and Michelle.

Mr. Lapointe was employed for 27 years as a machinist at MACOM. He was a parishioner of the former Sacred Heart Church.

Alfred was a simple and genuine family man. He loved his wife and children, and was very proud of his three grandchildren. He enjoyed family get-togethers, working around his home, and listening to music.
