LOWELL—Ann (Hayden) Hickey LeLacheur passed away Thursday morning, April 18, 2013 at her home, surrounded by her loving family. She was 83 years old. Ann was the wife of the late Thomas F. Hickey who died in 1976 and Edward A. LeLacheur who died in 2010.

Ann was born on Newhall Street in Lowell on September 11, 1929, a daughter of the late Lawrence and Mae (Carroll) Hayden. She was a graduate of the Sacred Heart Grammar School and Lowell High School, Class of 1947. At LHS, Ann was a member of the Girl Officer's Regiment. Ann and her husband Tom had eight children and Ann remained home to raise her family. She later worked outside of the home as a bank teller for the former Union National Bank, and in the Office of the Chief of Police for the University of Lowell, a job for which she was well known and highly regarded.

Ann was a lifelong member of the former Sacred Heart Parish. She held membership in the Holy Rosary Sodality, and was one of the first Lay Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at Sacred Heart Church. Ann loved living in and being a part of the Sacred Heart Community.

Ann was a multi-tasker and her strong-willed personality earned her the nickname "Sarge" around the Hickey Home. She was a Boston sports fan, especially rooting on the Celtics, Red Sox, and Patriots. She also enjoyed

reading and wintering in the Paradise Bay Estates Community of Bradenton, Florida. Ann loved the Palm Trees and sunsets that Florida had to offer. As the winter ended and spring came around, Ann couldn't wait to return home to be with her family, especially her grandchildren. Ann's family was central to her life. As the family matriarch, Ann would host Sunday Mornings at her home, where children and grandchildren would gather and drop in to visit with Grammie. She enjoyed being part of all of the things that her grandchildren were doing. Family was Ann's most cherished gift and her greatest legacy. Surviving Ann are her eight children, Thomas F.
