LOWELL—David L. Hemenway, 74, a resident of South Lowell, passed away peacefully at his home after a courageous battle with cancer. His fiancée, Barbara Edie was lovingly at his side, as she had been for 32 years. David was born in California on February 25, 1946, a son of Margaret Hemenway Snow.
