Donald Randlett Smith, age 90, passed away Monday, October 24, 2016, at the D'Youville Manor Nursing Facility after a period of declining health.

Don is survived by his wife of 20 years, Lillian (Lee) Smith. He was predeceased by his first wife, Helen (O'Loughlin) Smith, with whom he enjoyed 42 years of marriage. He was also the brother of the late Gardner and Marjorie Smith.

Don was born in Lowell, the son of William Byron Smith and Caroline (Scoble) Smith. He grew up in the Christian Hill neighborhood of the Centralville section of Lowell. After graduating from Lowell High School, Don enlisted in the US Navy and served on the destroyer USS Harold J. Ellison during the latter part of WWII. After his honorable discharge from service, Don worked at General Electric, Airtronics in Washington, DC, and at the former Sanders Associates of Nashua for 25 years, where he retired as Director of Contracts. After retirement, he moved to Chelmsford and enjoyed working part-time at his son Steve's company, S&H Engineering of Chelmsford.

Donald was a communicant of the former Sacred Heart parish and a communicant of St. Margaret's parish in Lowell. Don loved the ocean and body surfing the waves at Hampton Beach. He also enjoyed golf, ice skating, and walking. He was a quiet, kind and gentle man who without saying as many words demonstrated his care and concern for others by his actions. He had a great sense of humor and loved to entertain family and friends with his jokes and antics.
