PLYMOUTH, NH—Edward J. Silva passed away at his home on Wednesday, May 1, 2013 following a battle with cancer and heart disease. He was 75 years old.

Eddie was born in Dracut on August 5, 1937, a son of the late Joseph A. and Mary (Gomes) Silva.

He is survived by his sons, Joseph Silva of Minnesota and Anthony Silva of Florida, and his former wife, Elizabeth Silva of Lowell. Eddie was predeceased by his two daughters, Robin and Kelly Silva.

Eddie attended the Dracut Public School System, and joined the U.S. Army. He was honorably discharged in 1957.

Eddie worked for Brox Dairy and Garelick Farms Dairy for many years. He also owned and operated Silva Hog Farm on Broadway Road in Dracut, MA until his retirement, when he moved to Plymouth, NH. Eddie was an avid fan of the Boston Red Sox and The New England Patriots. His main passion was for his race horses. He was the owner of several horses that he raced at Rockingham Park and Suffolk Downs.

In addition to his two sons and former wife, Eddie is survived by his sisters, Mary L. Delaney of Dracut, Diana Brown of Milford, NH, and Natalie Hubert

and her husband Clem of Whitefield, NH; his brothers, Alphonse Silva and his wife Nancy of Lone, CA, Anthony Silva and his wife Yolanda of Hayward, CA, Richard Silva and his wife Ronnie of Oroville, CA, Albert Silva and his wife Cooky of Dracut, Frank Silva and his wife Karen of Fitchburg, and David Lavoie and his wife Kim of Lowell; his aunt, Sally Lippe of Lowell; his sister-in-law, Estelle Silva of Lowell, Henrietta Silva of CA; also many nieces, nephews, and many, many friends.

Eddie was predeceased by his brother John Silva and sister Mary Pimentel, and his brothers, John, August, Joseph, Daniel, and Manny Silva.
