PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA—Frederick "Fred" Souliotis, Sr., 77, passed away unexpectedly on August 30, 2014 at his home in Port Richey, Florida.

Fred was born in Lowell on May 29, 1937, a son of the late Louis Souliotis and Georgia (Bergolia) Souliotis Brown who survives him.

Fred was educated in the Lowell Schools. He was a Veteran of the United States Air Force.

While living in Lowell, he was a Member of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church.

A fixture in the Acre Neighborhood, Fred was a local entrepreneur, owning and operating several businesses. He was most noted for his proprietorship in the Acre News on Broadway, Fred's Country Store on Middlesex St., and Acre Hot Topping. While living in Florida, he owned and operated Fred's Bakery in Tarpon Springs, a community which boasts the highest percentage of Greek Americans of any city in the United States.

Fred was the father of the late Louis Souliotis who died in 2010.

Fred is survived by his children, Dave Lamirande of Port Richey, FL, Walter Lamirande of Lowell, Fred Souliotis of Port Richey, FL, Robin Lamirande of Port Richey, FL, Tina Christian of Methuen, and Tammy Souliotis of Lowell; his

mother, Georgia Brown of East Haven, CT; his brother Butch Souliotis of Florida; his sisters, Helen Bean of Merrimack, NH and Mary Krall of Beaver Falls, PA; 14 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren. Fred was the former husband of Shirley A. (Thompson) Souliotis who died in 2007.
