She was 51 years old. Gail fought a brief and courageous battle with cancer.

She attended Lowell Schools and was a graduate of the Greater Lowell Regional Vocational Technical High School. As a teenager, Gail was a member of the Notre Dame de Lourdes Marching Band in Lowell.

A lifelong Lowell resident, Gail and her family made their home on Christian Hill in the Centralville neighborhood. She was a parishioner of St. Michael’s Church.

Early in her working career, Gail was employed at Wang Laboratories and at

As a mother, Gail was completely involved in her daughter's lives. She would volunteer and lend a hand in all of her daughter's activities. She was a member of the Lowell High School Cheerleader's Parent's Organization.
