LOWELL—Gary Anthony Donnelly, Sr., the loving husband of Deborah A. (Firth) Donnelly, and a resident of South Lowell, passed away following a brief illness, on Monday, June 17, 2013 at Lowell General's Saints Campus. He was 63 years old.

Gary was born in Lowell on December 22, 1949, a son of the late Leo J. Sr. and Helena M. (Hebert) Donnelly. He graduated from the Sacred Heart Grammar School and Lowell High School with the class of 1968. Mr. Donnelly was an Army Veteran of the Vietnam War and received the Purple Heart for wounds received in action. He was honorably discharged in 1971.

For over 30 years Gary was employed with the United States Postal Service. He retired in 2003 after many years as a window clerk at the Tewksbury Post Office.
