Gary fought a courageous battle waiting for a liver and kidney transplant at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston. Gary was born in Stoneham, MA on August 6, 1991. When Gary was three years old, he received a liver transplant. He attended Lowell Schools and was a graduate of Landmark Academy. Gary had been employed at General woodworking.

Gary enjoyed hanging out in Connecticut with the “Three Amigos” Steve, Brian, and Zach. He enjoyed trips to Las Vegas with PA. He was a big sports fan, especially of the Boston Bruins. Gary loved watching the Sopranos with Johnny, and eating his favorites, Espresso Pizza and roast beef subs. Most of all, Gary enjoyed spending time with his family and the people he loved the most.

Gary’s family are devoted advocates of the importance Organ Donation and raising people’s awareness about the gift of life.
