Venice, Florida – George Thomas "Jim" Carr, 93 died peacefully on April 2, 2016 at Harbor Chase Assisted Living.

Born in Charlestown, MA in 1923, Jim was the son of Daisy and William Carr. Jim was raised in Melrose, MA and lived there for over 45 years, raising his own family there in a beautiful house he built for them. He was married for 62 years to the late Dori (Corkery) Carr who died in 2010.

Jim enlisted in the United States Navy during World War II, and became a member of the Seabees. He was stationed in the Philippines and the Aleutian Islands, Alaska and received several medals and ribbons. Following his service he worked as a machinist at the South Boston Navy Shipyard.

He and his wife retired to Venice, FL in 1979, and spent many happy years there enjoying life to the fullest. He was a great golfer, avid bridge player, square danced with Dorie, and an excellent handyman always helping out his neighbors and friends.

He will be remembered for his quick wit, kindness, a twinkle in his eye, and always being a gentleman.
