In 1984 Gerald was yet again promoted to Deputy Chief and assigned to Car 3. Gerald stayed at this post until his retirement on September 15, 2000. Gerald was well rounded and had many interests. He enjoyed cars of all kinds and was very handy when it came to working on them. He loved golf and would play whenever he could. He was also a skier and a racquetball player. Gerald was also a member of the Lowell Elks. Gerald was a well-respected gent in his place of work, in his home, and especially by his entire family. He will be missed by all who knew him, and loved him, and were loved by him. Gerald is survived by his wife, Donna (Martin) Sullivan of N.
