LOWELL-----James Francis “Jim” Delehanty, 87, passed away on Friday morning, August 15, 2014 at the Merrimack Valley Hospice House in Haverhill. Jim was the husband of Ann M. (Nadeau) Delehanty, to whom he was married for 63 years.

James F. Delehanty was born in Lowell on June 2, 1927, a son of the late James A. and Anna (Lemire) Delehanty. He was a graduate of St. Peter’s Grammar School and Lowell High School. Upon graduation, Jim enlisted in the U.S. Navy during WWII. He served aboard the USS Rush. He was honorably discharged on August 14, 1946. Jim reenlisted in the Navy and also served during the Korean War.

Jim was employed as a machine operator for General Electric for 32 years. He later worked part time at Bradlees and J.M. Fields.

Jim was a parishioner of St. Marie’s Church, now Holy Family Parish. For all of his married life, everything Jim and Ann did revolved around St. Marie’s Church. Jim was a past president of the Holy Name Society and was an organizer and volunteer for countless church activities, including cookouts and Bingo.

Jim was an outdoorsman and loved being outside and traveling to outdoor places. He enjoyed doing things around the house, working in his yard, and when everything was finished, resting in his hammock. Most of all, Jim enjoyed spending time with and being around his family.

In addition to his wife Ann, Jim is survived by his seven children, Gail Delehanty of Lowell, Gary Delehanty and his wife Susan of Tyngsboro, Karen Carmichael and her husband Rev. Donald of Grantham, NH, Mary Dobson and her husband David of Chichester, NH, Barbara Joslin and her husband Herman of Lowell, Jane Lewis and her husband Burnell of Plymouth Meeting, PA, and Michael Delehanty of Lowell; fourteen grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; his sister, Maureen O'Neil of Dracut; also many nieces, nephews, and cousins.
