CHELMSFORD--James P. Foley, a long-time resident of Chelmsford, MA, passed away on Thursday, April 7, 2022 at home. Born February 17, 1943 in Lowell, MA to James P. and Mary R. (McCabe) Foley, Jim had two sisters: the late Sister St. James (Patricia) and Margaret Foley. In 1966, Jim and Mary (Buchinkas) of Barre, MA, wed and they shared 56 years of marriage.

Jim worked for many years as a nuclear power engineer at Stone & Webster in Boston, MA. He later continued his work in the nuclear power industry as a consultant, working to improve safety at various power plants.

Jim loved the outdoors and when his children were young, he took the family on many camping and hiking trips over the years. When out in nature, he was never without a copy of Peterson's Guide to Eastern Birds in his back pocket. He loved looking for and identifying interesting birds. He had a passion for alpine skiing and passed this love on to his family.
