Jessie B. (Choate) Horne, of Lowell, died the 29th day of November, 2011 at Hannah Duston Healthcare Center in Haverhill after a lengthy illness, aged 71 years. She was the beloved wife of the late Wilbert Horne, Sr.

Born in York, South Carolina, December 2, 1939, she was a daughter of the late A. Y. and Beatrice (Boyd) Choate. She received her early education in the York school system, and attended York High School.
