LOWELL—Jimmy Lee Boykins, 63 passed away on Wednesday evening, September 24, 2014 at the Merrimack Valley Hospice House in Haverhill. He was the beloved husband of Colleen (Murphy) Boykins, to whom he was married for 42 years.
