LOWELL—John Joseph Kelley, a former Lowell resident and the husband of the late Rita Kelley, passed away on Friday morning, February 12, 2016 at the Blaire House in Tewksbury. He was 87 years old.

John was born in Lowell on November 9, 1928, the son of the late George and Katherine (Donohoe) Kelley. He was a graduate of the Sacred Heart Grammar School and Keith Academy.
