LOWELL—John William Quealy, 84, passed away on Friday afternoon, December 14, 2012 at Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley, following a brief illness.

John was born in Lowell on May 22, 1928, the only son of the late John and Margaret (O'Malley) Quealy. He was a graduate of the Sacred Heart Grammar School and Lowell High School.

John served with the United States Army during the Korean War.

As a young man, John worked at the Lowell Cemetery on Lawrence Street.

He was later employed for many years as a Corrections Officer, first at Walpole and later at Concord.

John was a quiet and polite gentleman. He enjoyed the outdoors and working in his yard. He was well known for his daily walks, where he would see friends and neighbors alike. He likes football and baseball, especially the Boston Red Sox. A lifelong parishioner of the Sacred Heart Church, John was a daily communicant.
