LOWELL—John T. "Jack" "Red" Dwyer, Jr., 81, passed away on Sunday, February 23, 2025 at Lowell General Hospital. Born in Lowell on September 27, 1943, he was the only son of the late John T. Sr. and Viola (Coutu) Dwyer. Jack attended the Sacred Heart Grammar School, followed by the Sacred Heart School for Boys in Andover until graduation. He then attended Lowell High School, graduating with the class of 1962.

Jack began his career with the City of Lowell Parks Department, spending 36 years, most of them as the perennial caretaker and foreman at Cawley Stadium and later Shedd Park. He was a parishioner of the Sacred Heart Parish until its closing, then later the Immaculate Conception Church. Red held membership in the Lowell Lodge of Elks for over 55 years, also the East End Club and the Ancient Order of Hibernians.

Jack is survived by his three sisters, Marjorie Chulak, Claire McDermott, and Justine Reed. He also leaves many nieces, nephews, and friends. Jack was the brother of the late Ruth Doyle, and brother-in-law of the late Russell Doyle, Al Chulak, Frank McDermott, and John C. Reed.
