Joseph “Bud” L. Ahearn Jr., age 75, a retired electrician of Dracut, passed away on October 9, 2021 at home while being cared for by family following a short battle with cancer.

Joseph was born in Lowell, MA to Mary (Hartigan) and Joseph L. Ahearn Sr. He graduated from Lowell High School and obtained his undergraduate degree in Business Administration from Lowell Technological Institute. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and upon returning obtained his Masters electrician’s license. In 1973, he married his childhood sweetheart, Gail J. Keirstead, who preceded him in death on November 10, 2019.

Joseph, known as Bud to family and friends, was an avid outdoorsman and nature enthusiast who enjoyed fishing and hunting trips with his brothers and friends.
