LOWELL—Joseph Timothy Duggan, 98, passed away peacefully on Friday, August 14, 2015 at Wingate at Belvidere. He was the beloved husband of the late Alice G. (Mahoney) Duggan, who passed away on December 20, 2006. Joseph was born in Lowell on December 3, 1916, a son of the late Francis and Helen (Lynch) Duggan. He was a graduate of the Sacred Heart Grammar School and Keith Academy in Lowell.

Joseph enlisted in the United States Army during WWII and served for three and a half years in the European, African, Middle Eastern Theater of Operation. Staff Sergeant Duggan received numerous awards and medals including the Purple Heart in June of 1945.

Prior to his retirement, Joseph was employed with the United States Post Office in California and Florida.

Joseph enjoyed watching the Boston Red Sox and traveling around the world with the love of his life, Alice.
