Lawrence “Larry” Hickey, 63, a lifelong resident of Lowell, MA, passed away at his home on March 8, 2019. Born in Lowell, on November 24, 1955, to the late Thomas F. and Ann (Hayden) Hickey, “LH” as he was often called, was the 3rd of 8 children of a large well-known Lowell family. He graduated from the Sacred Heart School, attended Keith Academy until its closing in 1970 and graduated from Lowell High School, class of 1973.
