LOWELL—Lillian Perry, a lifelong Lowell resident, passed away on Monday evening, July 4, 2011 at a local nursing home. She was 85 years old.

Lillian loved to travel and enjoyed many trips to Fall River on weekends to visit with family and friends. Lillian loved to be around her family.

Surviving Lillian are her God child, Lillian Burke of Nashua, NH; and several

nieces, nephews and cousins. Lillian is also survived by Michael Breton of Dracut, who looked after her care following the death of his mother, Irene Morin of Andover, a longtime friend and coworker of Lillian's. Lillian spent many holidays and special occasions in the company of her late friends, Irene and Donald Morin of Andover. In her later years, both Irene and Donald took very good care of Lillian, making sure she had everything she needed and she was always comfortable.
