LOWELL—Loretta Mary (Flynn) LaBelle, 93, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 4, 2022 at D'Youville Senior Care Center, with members of her family at bedside. She was the wife of the late Joseph Paul LaBelle for sixty-one years before his death in 2016.

Loretta was born in Lowell on August 3, 1929, a daughter of the late Thomas F. and Margaret L. (Carroll) Flynn.
