



## Mrs. Magda M. MacIver

January 2, 1933 - September 10, 2018

Magda M. MacIver, 85, passed away on September 10, 2018, at Lowell General Hospital, following a brief illness. She is survived by her two daughters, Katherine M. MacIver (Kathy) of Lowell, and Elizabeth A. Almarode (Lisa) and her husband James of Lebanon, Oregon; a granddaughter Lindsey Almarode; and by her beloved cat, Sunshine; also, nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews, and caring friends and neighbors. Her former husband, Bruce MacIver, passed away in 2017, and her sister Else passed away in 2014.

For the last decades of her life, her daughter Kathy lived with her and they provided mutual support and companionship; this gave her great joy and purpose in life. She gave of herself selflessly and tirelessly, and she had unmatched perseverance and determination to do what is right and what needs to be done. She is deeply missed.
