He enjoyed watching sports, especially the Patriots and Red Sox. Mark was very compassionate like his Mom and sisters. He attended Church Services at the Lowell Assembly of God.

Mark is survived by his parents, Helen Thurston of NH, James C. Jensen and his wife Jane M. (Duessault) Jensen of Dracut; his sisters, Mandy McGowan of Lowell, Jacqueline M.
