LOWELL—Melissa Marie Dunn passed away surrounded by those who loved her on Sunday, January 30, 2022 at Lowell General Hospital, following a brief illness. She was 45 years old.

Melissa was born in Lowell on August 12, 1976, the only daughter of William “Bill” and Marie “Tootsie” (Trainor) Dunn who survive her. She was educated in Lowell Schools and was a graduate of Lowell High School, class of 1994.
