LOWELL—Mildred C. (Farmer) Ciszek passed away peacefully in her sleep on Thursday, October 28, 2021. She was 102 years old.

Millie was the loving wife of Stanley Ciszek (LPD) who passed away on May 5, 1965.

Mildred C. Farmer was born in Lowell on June 11, 1919, one of ten children of Michael J. Farmer from County Clare, Ireland, and Mildred (Noble) Farmer from Concord, NH. She was educated in the Lowell Schools. She was employed in her early career at McGowan-Educator Biscuit Co. and later Scotty Shoe on Lawrence St. For 37 years she was the beloved Cook at the Sacred Heart Rectory on Moore Street.

Millie loved life. She loved people, kids, and family. She loved to cook. She loved the priests at Sacred Heart Parish. She loved the beach, music, concerts at the beach, and dancing. She met her husband Stanley dancing. She loved chocolate, especially Dove's, and was known as the "Candy Lady" at Northwood. Everything she did and everywhere she went she was love. She helped to raise her 9 siblings growing up. Millie loved shopping and buying things for everyone. She brought the party wherever she went! Millie retired at the young age of 83. She had been a resident of Northwood Nursing

Home since 2016, where she enjoyed her final years with excellent care and support from the staff and residents.
