CHELMSFORD—Muriel F. (Cole) Laurin, the beloved wife of Lloyd S. Laurin, died peacefully at Northwood Care Facility on Friday, February 10, 2017. She was 85 years old.

Muriel was born in Lowell on January 30, 1932, a daughter of the late Edwin and Muriel (Wilkins) Cole of Chelmsford, MA. She attended Chelmsford Schools and was a graduate of Chelmsford High School, Class of 1949.

Muriel then went on to graduate from the Lowell General Hospital School of Nursing with the Class of 1952.

Muriel married Lloyd S. Laurin of Lowell in 1953 and followed him to Key West, Florida where he was stationed in the Navy.

In April of this year, they would have celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary.

Muriel was an active member of the CHS Alumni Class of 1949 and the LGH Alumni. She was also an active member of the Fellowship United Methodist Church, before its closing in 2007.

Mrs. Laurin retired from Nursing at Lowell General in 1994 and moved to Polo Park in Davenport, Florida with her husband Lloyd. There they spent the next 20 years enjoying retirement. Muriel was extremely active in the social life of the retirement park, especially water aerobics, where she led the classes.

She loved spending time with her family, camping and traveling, making 13 trips to Bermuda to celebrate Thanksgiving with her AAA family.
