On October 11, 2023, Myrt Robinson was called home by her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. She was the beloved wife of Vincent Edward Robinson, to whom she was married for 72 years prior to his death in 2012.

Myrt was born in Somerville, MA on September 30, 1921, and was the daughter of Alphee E. LeTourneau and Elizabeth J. (Cummings) LeTourneau. She had two brothers and three sisters.

Myrt's special gift was serving others, and she was known for her delicious desserts. Her love of baking kept her family very happy with desserts for any occasion or just because, and her collection of recipes goes back to when she was first married in 1939. She never went anywhere without bringing a dessert and would put together her famous chocolate "war cake" at a moment's notice. She enjoyed working with her hands and was accomplished at counted cross stitch, crocheting, sewing and knitting. Her great grandson, Jake, reminded us that Meme always had stories to tell, memories of growing up during the depression and working a Rosie the Riveter job during WWII while her husband served overseas; stories of traveling cross country several times and camping with her husband, making life long friends along the way.

Myrt had a strong faith in God, relying on constant prayer for strength and guidance. She and Vin served in many ministries over the years where they

were former members of The Church of the Open Bible, Burlington, MA, and Marsh Corner Community Church, Methuen, MA.

“Meme’s” family meant everything to her and she leaves behind her daughter, Donna E. (Robinson) Mrozowski and her husband, William L. of Lowell, whom she adored; her cherished grandchildren, William E. Mrozowski and his wife, Megan (Giblin) of Lowell and Stacey (Mrozowski) Helgerson and her husband, Joel of Amherst, NH; her five most precious great grandchildren, Ryan and Jake Mrozowski and Kathryn, Madelyn and Allyson Helgerson.
