LOWELL—Patricia A. Britton, 75, passed away peacefully on Wednesday afternoon, September 4, 2013 at D’Youville Senior Care Center, following a brief illness.

She was raised in the Swede Village Neighborhood and was a graduate of The B.F. Butler School and Lowell High School, with the class of 1956. During her professional career, Pat completed many banking courses at the University of Lowell, now UMASS Lowell.

Pat enjoyed a 20 year career in Banking before transitioning to her job with the Town of Chelmsford, serving in the Tax Collectors Office.
