LOWELL—Patrick J. McCarthy, 52, the beloved son of Viola B. McCarthy, passed away on December 7, 2010 at the Lahey Clinic in Burlington, following a brief illness.

Patrick was born in Lowell on February 21, 1958, a son of Viola B. (Muldoon) McCarthy of Lowell who survives him and the late James P. McCarthy who died in 1977.

Pat received his education in the Lowell School System and was a graduate of Lowell High School, class of 1976. He also attended Niagara University in Niagara Falls, NY. He was a parishioner of the Immaculate Conception Church.

For many years, Pat was affiliated with the family business, James P. McCarthy & Sons of Lowell, a food service and distribution company. Pat was a kind and lively individual. His passion was politics, especially local politics. Pat was a spirited political activist in Lowell, the city he loved so much.
