LOWELL—Paul Barton Steinberg entered into rest on July 12, 2016, at his home in the Highlands, surrounded by his loving wife and children.

He was the devoted husband of Annette M. (Walsh) Steinberg, with whom he celebrated 44 years of marriage.

Paul was born in Lowell on April 30, 1948, a son of the late Lester A. and Evelyn (Coltin) Steinberg. He was educated in the Lowell Schools and was a 1966 graduate of Lowell High School.

Paul graduated from UMASS Boston in 1975 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Education.

For most of his professional career, Paul was employed in Electrical Sales. He also enjoyed many part time jobs. Paul was a Bartender at the Windsor Mills Restaurant, a Disc Jockey, an Usher for both the Lowell Spinners and the MRT, and a School Bus Driver at Lowell Catholic High School. Through all of those jobs and the many hats he wore, his first and most important position was that of husband to Annette and father to Matt, Greg, Danny, and Liz.

Paul was a true family man. He was ever present in his kids' lives as a coach, spectator, and a fan. Mr. Steinberg coached Lowell Youth Soccer, Highlands

Basketball, Little League, and Softball. In addition to this, he was always at his children's practices, games, meets, and recitals, sometimes with quiet words of encouragement, and other times with Rally Cries to get them and everybody pumped up.

Paul loved the Boston Sports Teams and was also a fan of the local sports teams as well. He enjoyed an occasional trip to Las Vegas to try his luck. With his wife Annette, he loved to travel, go out to dinner, go to the beach, and attend the Theater and Musicals. He loved to dance, and was a huge Jimmy Buffett fan.

Breakfast was one of his favorite meals, and he loved a great diner.

Paul always stayed involved in his community. He volunteered and served on committees. He was a member of the LHS Class of 1966 Reunion Committee.

Paul was a hard worker for his entire life, until his illness forced him to stop.

Throughout his diagnosis, he remained optimistic and positive.

Paul was a quiet and humble presence. He loved his family, and his family loved him.
