LOWELL—Richard R. “Rich” Mansfield passed away at his home on January 2, 2021 following a long illness. He was the beloved husband of Barbara L. (James) Mansfield, who passed away on July 15, 2020.

Richard was born in Lowell, the son of the late James V. and Alice M. (Sayer) Winters. He was educated in the Lowell Schools and was a 1969 graduate of Lowell High School.
