He attended Lowell Public Schools and joined the United State's Army on February 17, 1955 at age 17. Robert was appointed to a five-year term to the Lowell Housing Authority in 2001 where he served as Commissioner, Vice Chairman and Chairman. In 2015 Robert was appointed by Governor Baker & Lt. Governor Polito and served as Vice Chairman until 2022. He also served as a Rogers Hall Board Member. Other Memberships included; Lowell Lodge of Elks, East End Social Club, Lowell and Chelmsford Cribbage Leagues and Long Meadow Golf Club. He supported Friends of Lowell High School Wrestling Program and the Salvation Army. Bob and Audrey were married on July 1, 1956 at Sacred Heart Church in a double wedding ceremony shared with Bob's brother Gerald and Audrey's

sister Frances. Audrey and Bob were blessed with a large loving family of one daughter and four sons. Their family grew in number to nine grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. Family meant everything to Bob. His greatest joy in life was his family. He was a dedicated father and husband.
