LOWELL, MA — Robert E. Kenney, 66, a longtime resident of Lowell, passed away on Monday, January 20, 2025, at High Pointe Hospice House in Haverhill, surrounded by loved ones.

Born on July 3, 1958, in Lowell, Bobby – as he was known to his friends (Robert to his family) – was the son of the late William J. (Red) Kenney and Lenore (Sousa) Kenney. A lifelong sports enthusiast, he had a deep passion for golf. Because of his love for and dedication to Long Meadow Golf Club, he was honored with a Lifetime Membership, something he was incredibly proud of. He also served as Club president from 2000 to 2002.
