LOWELL—Ronald Marcotti, age 68, passed away unexpectedly at his home on Saturday, November 26, 2016.

Ronald was born in Medford on January 6, 1948, a son of the late Chester, Jr. and Catherine (Morrissey) Marcotti. He was the third oldest of four brothers, Chester Marcotti, III, Thomas Marcotti, and Michael Marcotti. He was a resident of Medford from 1948 until 1959 and attended St. Joseph's Elementary School. In 1959, the Marcotti family relocated to Anaheim, California. Ronald attended Freemont Jr. High School and graduated from Anaheim Union High School in 1966. Following high school, his family moved back to Wakefield Massachusetts. Ronald attended Fitchburg State University and received a degree in Mechanical Engineering. Ronald was a highly skilled machinist for over 30 years. He worked at Wang from 1980-1986 and Raytheon from 1986–1994. He was most recently employed at L3 Communications in Wilmington, MA. Ronald was a man of many talents and passions. The Marcotti family has a lineage of talented musicians and artists, and it was no wonder he was a natural when it came to playing guitar (and trombone in his former high school days). He was also an incredible illustrator, artist, and craftsman. His talents were apparent early in his childhood when he won an art award given to him by the Archdiocese around the age of 7. He has crafted and hand-built some of his own custom guitars, knives, and even furniture. He loved martial arts and was a second-degree black belt in Jiu-Jitsu and stayed fit by cycling, roller blading and meeting his children at the local gym for a family kickboxing session. Ronald was also an avid outdoorsman, and went on numerous fishing and camping trips at his favorite campground Millbrook in Errol, NH. You would often find him fly-fishing on his boat and enjoying the beauty of nature. His biggest love was for his family, his 3 children Sheri, Jason and Steven, his 4 grandchildren, Matthew, Ashley, Joshua, and Sophia, his 3 brothers, Chet his wife Toni, Tom and his wife Helen, and Mike and his wife Wendy) and numerous nieces and nephews including Mike Marcotti, Angel Marcotti Czeremin and her daughter Kari, Patrick, Nicholas and Cara Marcotti, and Tina Pulli.
