Rose M. (Geary) Dowling passed away peacefully at home on February 5, 2018. She was the widow of Edward O. Dowling, Sr. who passed away in May 1971.

Rose was born on November 2, 1926, the third of seven children to John and Agnes (O'Donnell) Geary. Raised in Lawrence, MA, she was educated at St. Augustine's Grammar School and St. Mary's High School. After high school she worked at the electric company until the birth of her first child. Later, Rose worked at the Sacred Heart Parish Rectory in Lowell for nearly 30 years until its closing in 2004, when she "finally" retired.

Rose was an active member of the Sacred Heart parish community, where she was one of the first Eucharistic Ministers, a CCD teacher, a Cub Scout den mother, band mom, and participant in the annual Variety Show. She enjoyed taking trips with the Sacred Heart retirees, but most of all she loved her time with "the girls," especially their monthly lunches. Her best friends, the girls were always so thoughtful to Rose, sending her prayers, cards, and sweet notes when she was unable to attend. She kept every one of them.

Rose enjoyed reading, word searches, traveling, and spending time with her

family. She also loved going on “Rose days,” which included going off to the beach with Beth and down to Foxwoods with Cathy and Jan. She was always up for fun and adventure, and her humor will be sadly missed.
