Rosemary A. Trainor, 91, a longtime resident of Chelmsford, passed away peacefully on Friday, February 12, 2021 after a period of declining health. The beloved wife of the late Thomas J. 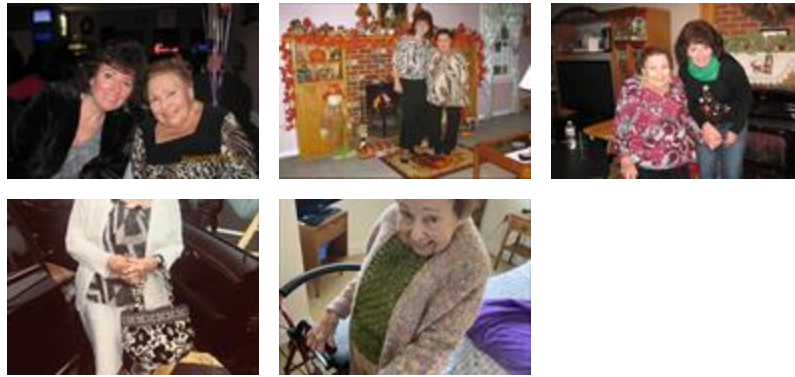
