LOWELL—Theodore Brooks Oxton passed away on Wednesday, February 19, 2014 at Lowell General Hospital, following a brief illness. He was 68 years old and was the beloved husband of Leslie J. (Messia) Oxton, with whom he would have celebrated 36 years of marriage March 12, 2014.

Theodore was born in Weymouth on July 7, 1945, a son of the late Roy and Alva (Newton) Oxton. He attended Billerica Schools and enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1963, serving for five years. Specialist Oxton was decorated as a Sharpshooter, Marksman, and a Weapons Expert.

Mr. Oxton was employed for 35 years as a mechanic for the City of Lowell in the Department of Public Works and later the Water Department. Mr. Oxton held membership in the Lowell Lodge of Elks #87 and the American Legion Post 247 Tyngsborough.
