LOWELL—Viola B. (Muldoon) McCarthy, 91, a member of a well known Lowell family, passed away on Tuesday evening, November 8, 2011 at Saints Medical Center, following a brief illness. She was the beloved wife of the late James P. McCarthy who died in 1977.
