Wesley W. "Wes" Cox, 74 years old, died peacefully at home with family on December 27, 2022. He was the husband of Donna (Fagan) Cox, for the past 53 years. Born in Lowell on February 26, 1948, Wes was the son of the late Wesley H. Cox and Mary T. Austin. He was educated in Lowell, MA and Azusa, CA public schools, graduating from Lowell High School with the Class of 1966. While at Azusa High School, Wes played baseball, football and basketball.
