William H. Sheridan, 87, died peacefully, August 27th, at D’Youville Senior Care Center in Lowell, following a brief illness. Born in Lowell on December 13, 1922, William was the beloved son of the late Thomas S. and Alice (Shea) Sheridan. He attended Sacred Heart School and was a graduate of Lowell High School. Bill was a life-long member of the Sacred Heart Parish.

Bill was a World War II Veteran, having served as a Sergeant in the Army Air Force. He served in the European Theatre for 3 years. Bill’s Air Force Base celebrated a “100th Mission Celebration” with one of the final performances by the Glen Miller Band, just prior to Miller’s plane going down over the English Channel.

Returning home from the service, Bill worked for the Harvard Brewery in Lowell and had a 25 year career as a Corrections Officer for the Billerica House of Corrections. Bill enjoyed travelling to the Boston Garden for professional wrestling bouts with his nieces and nephew. He took numerous trips to visit Times Square and New York City.

In his retirement, Bill was content to lead a simple life dedicated to his family.

He cared for his mother, Alice, until her death in 1980. He was a supportive brother and much loved uncle to his nieces and nephews. He was a man of few words, loved by all, and fondly known as “Uncle Bill.”

Bill was the younger brother and brother-in-law to Edward and Laura Sheridan, and Thomas and Lillian Sheridan, who predeceased him. He is survived by his brother Leo J. Sheridan and his wife Rita of Lowell. He also leaves nine nieces, nephews and their spouses, Thomas and Sandy Sheridan, Billy Sheridan and the late Mary Sheridan, Sister Ann Louise Sheridan, SSMN, Patricia and David Hall, Kathleen and Vincent Maloney, Linda and Michael Gallagher, Leo and Cheryl Sheridan, Lisa and Shawn Slattery, Deborah and William Gilligan, and many grand nieces and nephews.
